PEPPERMINT STRIPE

These piece are done on bisque using a Majolica Technique.

<u>Basecoat</u>—With soft fan brush apply 3 coats of Matt Medium to the outside of the candy dish and the entire mug and 2-3 coats of Gloss Medium to the inside of the Candy Dish.

<u>Stripes</u>—With #10 Square Shader or Medium Paula Sumi and Deep Cranberry (Conditioned with Matt Medium) pull in large stripes and outside of handle on mug. Small stripes are done with a liner after the holly's are completed.

<u>Holly</u>—With #10 square shader and Green Leaf (Conditioned with Matt Medium) Stroke in Holly leaves with 2 coats. Shade the outsides of each leaf with Hunter Green (Conditioned with Matt Medium).

<u>Holly Berries</u>—With small Paula Sumi fill in 1-2 coats on Holly berries with Deep Cranberry (Conditioned with Matt Medium.)

<u>Detail:</u> With liner brush and Cobalt Black with 2 drops of Matt Medium, pull in detail lines on holly leaves and berries.

Allow project to completely dry. Stilt and fire to witness cone 06.

CSP03 Matt Medium: Creates a beautiful satin finish.

- It is naturally transparent.
- Base is non toxic and creates a food safe finish.
