Brushes

Medium Sumi Brush 455-0 CFE Class Brush 3600-2 Kolinsky Liner

- 1. Pipe all the lines with black paste.
- 2. Mix all colors to proper consistency.
- 3. Flood and fill all areas as indicated on pattern.
- 4. Tulip and flower are done with 2 & 3 color blend method. G310 Vermillion, G332 Deep Cranberry and G337 Bright Violet.
- 5. After color is dry you can use the 3600-#2 Liner and DB101 Detailing Black to add detail on leaves, petals. This will make them stand out from the other areas and also touch up any lines that the enamels may have went over. It is a way to touch up lines.
- 6. Use the medium Sumi brush and any colors that you want to decorate the platform to match your glass panel. This is a ceramic bisque piece and absorbs the enamels really quick so you may need to tip the brush into some GM300 Glass Medium every now and then to create a watercolor look. DO NOT add any of the enamels to the back of the platform where you will attach the plastic fixture. It needs to be bare bisque to apply glue to.


