



CFE High Fires (Porcelain or Stoneware)

Color Concentrates or Professional Studio Pigments can both be used on Porcelain and Stoneware, Cone 6. Some of the Pinks and Purples have a tendency to burn away. We recommend that you do a test firing. You can use on greenware or soft-fire (010) and apply wash of color and wipe back for antiquing. CFE Clear Glaze is slightly leaded and is not recommended over colors at a cone 6. It will run or bleed the colors. CSP01 Gloss Medium NT Clear can be applied to Cone 6 ware and fired to Cone 06.



Color Concentrates

Pure Color Concentrates slightly thinned for brushing applied to Porcelain greenware. The colors will be a matt finish.

CC123 Sunflowers
CC151 Cerulean Blue
CC152 Deep Cerulean
CC160 Key Lime
CC162 Laurel Green



CC's + CSP01 Gloss Medium

Color Concentrates mixed 50/50 with Gloss Medium and applied to Porcelain greenware. This will give the areas painted a gloss finish to them.

Same as above with CSP01 Gloss Medium added 50/50 to each.

Color Strokes/PSPs

Color Strokes/PSPs brush stroked on Porcelain greenware. The Color Strokes/PSPs will have a slight gloss here and there due to the frit(glaze) in the product. The more coats/heavier the application the more it will gloss.
