

**Floral Ceramic Plate**

**Background-**With CC160 Key Lime/CSP01 Gloss Medium 50/50 mix, and CC161 Green Leaf/CSP01 mix thinned with water apply a watercolor background around the pattern with medium sumi brush. Add both color here and there overlapping them Try not to get on the flowers if possible.

**Flowers**-CC116 Florida Orange/CSP01 Gloss Medium 50/50 blended with CC111 Red Geranium/CSP01 Gloss Medium 50/50 mix. Do a 2 color blend on the petals keeping the orange to the outside and red to the center of the petal. Do at least 2 to 3 coats on each petal allowing to dry in between each coat.

**Leaves-**CC161 Green Leaf/CSP01 Gloss Medium 50/50 and CC162 Laurel Green/CSP01 Gloss Medium 50/50 mix. Do a 2-color blend with the CC161 at the tips of the leaves and the CC162 at the base near the stem. 2 coats.

**Centers-**CC123 Sunflowers pat in 1-2 coats on the centers of the flowers, then add a little of the CC161 Green leaf on lower side.

**Stems-**With 3600-2 Liner brush and a mix of CC161/CC162 pull in the stems and center veins on leaves.

**Calyx-**With liner brush, load with CC161 and tip in CC162 and pull in calyx on the bud. Pull from the stem out. 1 coat.

**Detail-**With 3600-2 Liner and slightly thinned CC101 Cobalt Black detail design and add side veins on leaves. Refer to pattern and Video.

**Comma Strokes Boarder-**With #500-3 Bavarian round add comma strokes and line work around the edge as shown in the photo. Load with CC161 Green Leaf and tip in CC162 Laurel Green for each stroke. Glaze with fan brush and 2 coats of CSP01 Gloss Medium NT Clear.
